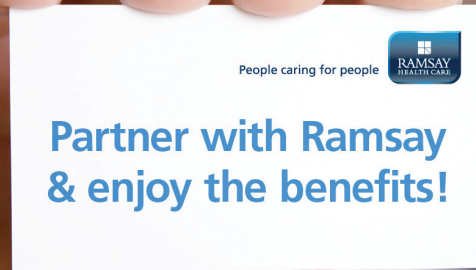


Hospital Medical Officer / GP

An opportunity exists for 2 salaried Medical Officers at Southern Highlands Private Hospital / Southern Highlands Cancer Centre. This is a unique opportunity that would suit Career Medical Officers or GP's wanting flexible working hours.

ABOUT THE JOB:

The Medical Officer is an integral and vital part of the hospital delivering quality clinical care and providing support to a range of Surgeons, Physicians and admitting GP's, in the treatment of their patients.

The Medical Officer roster will work 5 days per week (Monday to Friday) with 8hour shifts (8am to 5pm) with overnight on call. There may be some on-call at weekends from time to time. This would be a shared arrangement with other Medical Officers. It would be necessary for the Medical Officer to live locally or within 20 minutes of the Southern Highlands, to be available for on-call.

An attractive remuneration package is on offer, including an hourly rate of pay, plus superannuation. The usual leave entitlements apply, as well as 5 days supported study leave per annum (or pro rata part-time) including Medical Emergency Training (MET).

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Current general registration with AHPRA [Australian Health Professionals Regulation Agency];
- Minimum of 3 years Australian experience;
- Current indemnity insurance; and
- Current ALS (Advanced Life Support training) for adult / paediatric patients is an advantage.
